Worthwhile points to highlight

- *Attempts to employ a game plan improved significantly.*
- *Communicator skip!!!*
- *Leadership skip!!!*
- *Skip calls - some good.*
- *Skip's trust in third - some good.*
- *Skips engage your players, don't enrage them.*
- *Competing at minimum and maximum lengths predominantly.*
- *Call caterpillar for a delivery, where the previous one was great, as it raises both the confidence and intensity for bowler's next delivery.*
- *Skip and third calls - be decisive, don't tell the score, don't include negativity and doubt, show what you want as well as say what you want.*
- *Rink meeting so as to have a chance to review as you compete - ends 5/10/15 or ends 6/12/18.*
- *Drives - one team seems unwilling to drive as rink teams.*
- *Skips - don't bitch if front end are struggling, do something to improve their contribution, hence rink meeting opportunity, or else they and you both go.*
- *Competitive spirit displayed - team meeting pre bell.*
- *Losing numbers - objective kept to less than 10.*
- *Losing numbers - team meeting to enable front end to weigh in to the game plan.*
- *Discipline - add shot being convinced.*
- *Far too many skips are angry ants and as such destructive to the team fabric.*
- *And too many are also too anxious.*
- *Stretch the limits - jack delivery.*

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
